### Requirements

- Application deadline for entry is Friday, February 23rd, 2024.
- Official high school transcript required with application.
- Applicant must be a band member in good standing meeting current eligibility requirements and have been enrolled in the WISD band program for his/her entire junior and senior years.
- Applicant must plan to attend college during the 2024-2025 academic year
  with a <u>major or minor in music</u>. Recipients must provide enrollment
  verification and proof that the declared major is music (e.g. copy of tuition
  payment, course registration or other school issued enrollment verification
  verifying declared major) directly to the Band Boosters to receive funds.
- Funds will be distributed over two semesters. Student must maintain a
  minimum 2.5 GPA during the first semester to be eligible to receive funds
  for the second semester. Failure to maintain the minimum GPA will result
  in forfeiture of the remaining funds. In addition to providing proof of first
  semester GPA, 2<sup>nd</sup> semester students must once again provide enrollment
  verification and proof of continuing on with a music major (changing major
  away from a music major the second semester will result in forfeiture of
  remaining funds).
- First semester funds will be available for distribution after July 1, 2024 with proof of college enrollment (see above).
- Second semester funds will be available for distribution as soon as proof of college enrollment and GPA verification from first semester have been provided (see above).
- Both semester funds must be claimed before May 31, 2025 or they will be forfeited.
- If the scholarship recipient owes any money to the Waxahachie Band Boosters those funds will be deducted from the total award amount.
- Applicant must complete the attached application form and submit the form along with an official high school transcript to Mr. Armstrong.

- An audition in front of a panel of 3 5 judges will be held on <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>March 1, starting at 6:30 P.M.</u>. This judging panel will include, but is not limited to, WHS Band Directors.
  - Audition requirements:
    - Class I solo or Concerto with accompaniment. Must be college acceptable material.
    - Audition scheduling TBA.
- Final Award recipient(s) will be determined by the WHS Director of Bands.
  There is no requirement to award funds if applicants are deemed unworthy
  of the reward. Award amount is flexible, may vary from year to year, and
  may be split among multiple participants.
- Award recipients will be announced at the 2024 Band Banquet and recognized at the WHS Scholarship & Awards Ceremony in May 2024.
